<b>Course contents</b>	Life, work and philosophical thought of Friedrich Nietzsche, who as a person and philosopher has been a big question mark among the thinkers of the West, and as such puts in question almost everything; Analysis of how his emancipation figure has become a challenge to many people of today; The secret of his great influence on the people of today is being analyzed, in terms of the so called <i>magic extremes</i> of his works; His extremes acting as promises of the new horizons of human mind; Nietzsche as a model of emancipation and alternative life style of today; His importance for having brought up the subject of postmodernism in philosophy; Nietzsche's philosophical discussion of postmodernism; In this context, modernism and postmodernism are also being discussed; Postmodernism as a challenge to theological reflection.
