2. The receiving institution will send its decision within 4-6 weeks.

3. A **Transcript of Records** will be issued by the receiving institution no later than 5 weeks after the assessment period has finished at the receiving HEI. [It should normally not exceed five weeks according to the Erasmus Charter for Higher Education guidelines]

4. **Termination of the agreement:**

The above parties agree to co-operate in the activities shown below within the Erasmus + programme. Both parties agree to abide by the principles and conditions set out in the Guidelines for Applicants and Erasmus Charter. Both parties undertake to abide by the bilaterally agreed terms of this co-operation agreement.

In the event of unilateral termination, a notice of at least one academic year should be given. This means that a unilateral decision to discontinue the exchanges notified to the other party by 1 September 20XX will only take effect as of 1 September 20XX+1. Neither the European Commission nor the National Agencies can be held responsible in case of a conflict.

3. A **Transcript of Records** will be issued by the receiving institution no later than 4 weeks after the assessment period has finished at the receiving HEI. [It should normally not exceed five weeks according to the Erasmus Charter for Higher Education guidelines]

4. Termination of the agreement: [It is up to the involved institutions to agree on the procedure for modifying or terminating the inter-institutional agreement. However, in the event of unilateral termination, a notice of at least one academic year should be given. This means that a unilateral decision to
